#### 15. General Manager Update

- The collection rate for August was 98% with 68 cut offs; 6 remained unpaid.
- The collection rate for September was 99% with 38 cut offs; 18 remained unpaid.
- October 1<sup>st</sup>-Social media posts about discolored water were uploaded. The incidents appeared to be isolated; it was determined the district was not at fault.
- October 4<sup>th</sup>—Attended a free EP Grants Network training provided by the Rio Grande Council of Governments. Mr. Omar Martinez gave the training; he has prepared many successful grants and prepared the district's grant application for the digital meters which we were recently awarded.
- October 17<sup>th</sup>—the EDA approved the site certification for the Veterans Memorial. We may now begin the bidding process.
- October 31st—the El Paso County Sheriff's office will host a Trunk or Treat event at the Peter J.
  Herrera Patrol Station in Clint from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. All the surrounding communities are
  invited. The district will set up a table to provide water cycle materials as well as hand out candy
  to the children.
- The Veterans' Day ceremony will be held at 7:30 a.m. on Friday, November 8th, at Veterans Park. All veterans from Fabens and the surrounding areas are encouraged to attend. Breakfast will be provided after the ceremony.

### Field Manager Update

- Water loss at end of September was 11%; current water TDS is at 700, Ph averaging 7.3, and cl is at 1.7.
- Lead samples shipped back on September 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. Results confirmed NO POSITIVE Lead & Copper readings in the samples. 20 samples were taken from throughout the district.
- Lead Service Line Inventory was due on October 9<sup>th</sup>. Reported just under 2500 service line connections. Report covered meter number, location, identification of type of service line up to meter, identification of service line after meter. Identified just under 40 service lines up to meter with copper to pvc, copper to copper and plastic to copper. All tested lead free.
