7. Presentation from Fabens ISD and the County of El Paso on Cotton Valley Connect Broadband project.

Mr. Cristian Martinez, on behalf of the County of El Paso, was seeking a memorandum of understanding with El Paso County WCID #4 in order to receive funds through a grant from USDA to fund a project that will provide the towns of Fabens and Tornillo with access to a broadband network. Insights, the company that designed and will operate the network is suggesting their equipment be installed on top of the water tank on Bryan St. Counsel, taking direction from staff as to what terms are acceptable to the District and in consultation with a third party vendor and the district engineer, will begin work on drafting memorandum of understanding.

Discussion: Ms. Martinez requested approval from the board for the purchase of two motors for the Wastewater treatment plant blowers. After further discussion of the costs and warranties on the options, the board opted to approve the purchase of the EKC brand motors from Qannex.
