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## 5. Public hearing on 2025 Tax Rate.

Ms. Martinez informed the board that, due to the water district not qualifying for grants because the district does not have TCEQ violations and is not in the red, the district must obtain loans to pay for projects. Loans must be paid through district revenue. Although the district has a money market account, it was advised by Mr. Robert Tijerina, Financial Consultant, not to use funds in the money market account to pay down the most recently obtained loan, as those funds should remain untouched and reserved for unexpected emergencies. To meet the new loan obligation for the Ikard Lift Station, the new blending tank, and the equipping of Cypress Well, it is recommended that a 2025 Tax rate of 0.315268 be approved.
