When should you expect your deposit returned?

People were asking when deposits are returned. A bill guarantee deposit remains in the customers account until the account is closed. The final balance is taken from the deposit and any money left is returned in the form of a check to the mailing address listed on the account. Refund checks are issued monthly after the billing cycle and get mailed on the first of the following month.

Example: If you close out your account in May (before the billing cycle), the refund check will be in the mail by the 1st of June.

The water district has hardly qualified for grants. Unfortunately, when major projects are in need the district must request loans. The only way to qualify for a loan is to have a good collection rate. Deposits guarantee that at least some if not all the outstanding balances will be paid.
